SUBJECT: PERU TERRORISM UPDATE: SEPTEMBER 15 - 29

1. (U) THE FOLLOWING IS A LIST OF TERRORIST AND TERRORIST-RELATED INCIDENTS FOR THE PERIOD SEPTEMBER 15 - 29. WE COMPILED THIS LIST FROM PRESS REPORTS, CONTACTS WITH PERU'S ANTI-TERRORISM POLICE UNIT (DIRECTOR), AND OFFICIAL STATEMENTS BY THE DOP. THESE SOURCES TEND TO UNDER-REPORT INCIDENTS IN THE COUNTRYSIDE, PARTICULARLY IN THE APACHICO EMERGENCY ZONE AND THE UPPER MUALLACA VALLEY (HUAY).

2. (U) TWO INCIDENTS WERE REPORTED TOO LATE FOR INCLUSION IN OUR PREVIOUS TERRORISM UPDATE:

SEPTEMBER 13: THE MRTA SET OFF TWO BOMBS IN DOWNTOWN AREQUIPA, IN FRONT OF A BANK AND A POLICE CO-OP. NO INJURIES WERE REPORTED.

SEPTEMBER 14: SL BLEW UP ROAD CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT IN TULLPACANCHI, HUANCABAMBA DEPARTMENT. NO INJURIES WERE REPORTED.

3. (U) SEPTEMBER 16
CAJAMARCA - AN SL PATROL REPORTEDLY KILLED 8 PEASANTS AND HOUNDED ONE IN THE COUNTRYSIDE NEAR SAN MIGUEL DE ALGAMARCA. THE VICTIMS ALLEGEDLY HAD PROVIDED INFORMATION TO THE POLICE.

ISAN MARTINI - UNIDENTIFIED TERRORISTS ATTACHED THE POLICE STATION IN UCHIZA, KILLING TWO POLICEMEN AND HOUNDING THREE. ONE TERRORIST WAS KILLED.

LA LIBERTAD - THERE WERE SEVERAL EXPLOSIONS OF GOVERNMENT BUILDINGS AND POULTRY STORES. NO PERSONAL INJURIES WERE REPORTED.

1. (U) LIMA - A PROBABLE SL GROUP ENTERED THE PROVINCIAL CAPITAL OF JUNIN, SETTING OFF EXPLOSIVES IN FRONT OF GOVERNMENT OFFICES, THE POLICE STATION AND BANKS. THE ATTACKERS REPORTEDLY NUMBERED AS MANY AS 100. NOTE: PROBABLY EXAGGERATED. NO INJURIES WERE REPORTED. AFTERWARDS THE GROUP RAIDED A NEARBY PEASANT COOPERATIVE (ASOCIACION CHINCHAUCA) AND STOLE 100 SHEEP.

2. (U) PASCO - SUSPECTED SL MEMBERS ASSASSINATED JOURNALIST CARLOS MEDRANO IN CERROS DE PASCO.

SEPTEMBER 16

1. (U) UNIDENTIFIED ATTACKERS SET OFF A BOMB AT THE MUNICIPALITY OF HUACO, ABOUT 120 KILOMETERS NORTH OF LIMA. THERE WERE NO INJURIES.

2. (U) LIMA - A BOMB EXPLODED IN THE APRESTA PARTY HEADQUARTERS IN BARRANCA, ABOUT 100 KILOMETERS NORTH OF LIMA.

3. (U) LIMA - POLICE ARRESTED TWO SL MEMBERS IN A LIMA SLUR.

4. (U) LIMA - A POLICEMAN WAS SERIOUSLY INJURED WHEN A BOMB EXPLODED AT NIGHT IN FRONT OF A BANK IN LIMA'S MEJORES DISTRICT.

SEPTEMBER 17

1. (U) YAYACUCHO - A BOMB EXPLODED AT THE YAYACUCHO CITY RADIO STATION "LA VOZ".

SEPTEMBER 18

1. (U) YAYACUCHO - SUSPECTED SL MEMBERS SHOT A SOLDIER AT A FARMERS' MARKET IN HUANTA, AND STOLE HIS AUTOMATIC RIFLE. THE SOLDIER DIED TWO DAYS LATER.

2. (U) YAYACUCHO - UNIDENTIFIED PERSONS THREW A DYNAMITE CHARGE AT A MILITARY VEHICLE IN YAYACUCHO CITY. THE BOMB FAILED TO EXPLODE.

SEPTEMBER 19

1. (U) LIMA - UNIDENTIFIED TERRORISTS KILLED TWO POLICEMEN IN A LIMA LOWER-CLASS NEIGHBORHOOD.

SEPTEMBER 20

1. (U) YAYACUCHO - A CAR BOMB EXPLODED IN APACHICO CITY. NO ONE WAS HURT. THE CAR HAD BEEN STOLEN FROM AN ARMY SERGEANT.

- AYACUCHO - THE APRISTA PARTY REPORTEDLY ASSASSINATED CAPITAL OF VILCAHUAMAN, RAUDO LONG TIME AGO. HIS ASSASSINATED BY PROBABLE SL MEMBERS. HIS WIFE AND DAUGHTER WERE ALSO KILLED. GOPT REPORTEDLY HAS RECEIVED NUMEROUS DEATH THREATS FROM SL.

- QUINOS - SIX PRTA MEMBERS BROKE INTO A SCHOOL IN THE CITY OF MUANCAYO, AND LECTURED STUDENTS ON PRTA PRINCIPLES. THE TERRORISTS BRIEFLY TOOK THREE STUDENTS HOSTAGE WHILE THEY MADE THEIR GETAWAY.

SEPTEMBER 23

- AYACUCHO - AN SL PATROL REPORTEDLY KILLED THREE PEASANTS AND DESTROYED IRRIGATION FACILITIES IN MASINA.

- AYACUCHO - SL MEMBERS REPORTEDLY KILLED A POLICEMAN AND DAMAGED THE POWER PLANT IN VICHANCO.

- LIMA - THE PRTA HIJACKED A FOOD TRUCK AND DISTRIBUTED THE CONTENTS IN A LIMA SLUM.

SEPTEMBER 24

- QUINOS - SL ATTACKED TWO POLICEMEN IN MUANCAYO, KILLING ONE AND WOUNDING THE OTHER.

SEPTEMBER 25

- LIMA - BOMBS EXPLODED AT THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS:
-- THE HOUSES OF A BUSINESSMAN AND OF AN INSURANCE COMPANY EXECUTIVE;
-- THE BANCO EXTERIOR DE LOS ANDES Y ESPANA;
-- THE LIMA STOCK EXCHANGE.

SEPTEMBER 26

- AYACUCHO - FOUR BOMBS EXPLODED IN AYACUCHO CITY; NO PERSONAL INJURIES WERE REPORTED.

- ICA - TWO BOMBS EXPLODED IN THE CITY OF ICA DURING THE PRESENTATION OF AN AWARD TO NOTED APRISTA CONGRESSMAN FERNANDO LEON DE VIVERO.

- LIMA - LIMA BUSINESSMAN MAXIMO FREIDA MATSUMURA WAS KIDNAPPED BY EIGHT PERSONS AS HE LEFT HIS HOME. POLICE BELIEVE THE PRTA WAS RESPONSIBLE, AND THERE ARE NUMEROUS RUMORS THAT A SIZEABLE RANSOM HAS BEEN DEMANDED (SEE COMMENT AT PARA 5).

SEPTEMBER 27

- MARAS - TWO COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENTS SUFFERED MATERIAL DAMAGE FROM AN EXPLOSION.

- AYACUCHO - SL MEMBERS REPORTEDLY KILLED FOUR PEASANTS TRAVELLING FROM HUANTA TO THE FARMERS' MARKET IN LIBIO.

SEPTEMBER 28

- LIMA - POLICE ARRESTED THREE SUSPECTED TERRORISTS WHO HAD BEEN SURVEILLING THE HOUSE OF EX-UNITED LEFT PRESIDENT ALFONSO BARRANTES. THE SUSPECTS REPORTEDLY HAD REVOLVERS AND SEMIAUTOMATIC GUNS.

- MARAS - POLICE CLAIM THEY KILLED A TERRORIST TRYING TO PLACE A BOMB IN THE STATE TOURIST HOTEL IN CHIMBO.

- MARAS - TWO BOMBS WENT OFF IN CHIMBO. NO INJURIES OCCURRED.

SEPTEMBER 29

- MARAS - AN SL PATROL ASSASSINATED THE APRISTA MAYOR OF CATA, LOCATED IN THE POPULAR CALLEJON DE HUAYLAS RESORT AREA (CORDILLERA BLanca). A SECOND SL GROUP REPORTEDLY BLEW UP THE ANTENNA OF RADIO STATION TANCASHI.

- LIMA - A BOMB WENT OFF IN FRONT OF THE HOUSE OF A PHARMACEUTICAL COMPANY EXECUTIVE IN THE LIMA SUBURB OF LAS ISIDRAS. THERE WAS MATERIAL DAMAGE TO THE RESIDENCE AND NEARBY HOUSES.

- RPT: OTHER EVENTS:

- SEPTEMBER 21: THE GOVT REHEVED FOR 60 DAYS THE STATE OF EMERGENCY IN THE FOLLOWING 17 DEPARTMENTS:

AYACUCHO: PROVINCES OF CANSAZO, HUAMARCA, HUANTA, LA MAR, VICTOR FUJARDO, HUANCASANCOS, VILCAHUAMAN, SUCRE;

APURIMAC: CHINCHERO PROVINCE;

BUANCAYELICA: PROVINCES OF ACCOBAMBA, ANGARAS, CASTRO-VIREYRA, BUANCAYELICA, TAYACAJA, HUAYARA, AND CHURCAMPAS;

HUANUCO: AMBO PROVINCE AND THE DISTRICT OF MONZON IN HUANACAYAS PROVINCE.

- SEPTEMBER 23: FOLLOWING AN UPGRADE IN SL ACTIVITY, THE GOVT DECLARED A STATE OF EMERGENCY FOR A 60-DAY PERIOD IN FIVE PROVINCES IN APURIMAC DEPARTMENT. AFFECTED ARE THE PROVINCES OF ABANCAY, ANGARAS, ANTARIMBA, AND HUAYLAS, AND CRAB. THE POLICE ARE TO ASSUME CONTROL OF ABANCAY PROVINCE; THE REMAINING PROVINCES WILL BE CONTROLLED BY THE ARMED FORCES.

- SEPTEMBER 26: THE POLICE RAIDED A LIMA COQUITO/FUNDRAISER FOR THE LAWYERS ASSOCIATION THAT DEFENDS CAPTURED SL MEMBERS. THE POLICE ARRESTED ABOUT 200 PEOPLE; IT RELEASED 126 LAWYERS PRESENT THE SAME DAY, AND AFTER THREE DAYS LETTEN SUSPECTED TERRORISTS REMAINING. (GOVT JAGS HAD OUTSTANDING WARRANTS FOR 141 OF THESE 126.) THE PRO-SL PRESS PROTESTED VIGOROUSLY, CLAIMING THE POLICE HAD MISTREATED THE RETAINNEES AND HAD ARRESTED THEM ARBITRARILY.

3. IN COMMENT, THERE WAS A STATEMENT THAT OF RECENT ATTACKS DURING THE REPORTING PERIOD, DESCRIBED AS IN LIMA AND AREQUIPA, PARTICULARLY CONCERNING VICTIMS. POSSIBILITY THAT TERRORISTS--SUCH AS THE SHAKERS--WERE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SEPTEMBER 24 KIDNAPPING OF A LIMA BUSINESSMAN. DIRECTORATE INFORMS US THEY BELIEVE THE PRTA IN FACT CARRIED OUT THE KIDNAPPING, BUT THEY LACK DETAILED INFORMATION. THE VICTIM'S FAMILY REPORTEDLY IS OBEDIENT KIDNAPPERS' THREATS NOT TO TALK TO THE POLICE. THE DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY IN MOST OF APURIMAC DEPARTMENT FOLLOWS A SPECTACULAR SERIES OF 21 ATTACKS THERE IN THE LAST TWO MONTHS. THE PLACING OF AREQUIPA PROVINCE UNDER POLICE RATHER THAN MILITARY CONTROL REFLECTS A GDP PREFERENCE FOR MAINTAINING CIVILIAN AUTHORITY WHEREVER POSSIBLE. NATSON
