1. THE FOLLOWING IS A LIST OF TERRORIST AND TERRORIST-RELATED INCIDENTS FOR THE WEEK BEGINNING APRIL 29. WE COMPILED THE LIST FROM PRESS REPORTS, CONTACTS WITH PERU'S ANTI-TERRORISM POLICE UNIT (CIRCOTE), AND OFFICIAL ANNOUNCEMENTS BY THE MILITARY JOINT COMMAND. WHEN THE DATE OF THE INCIDENT IS UNKNOWN OR BEFORE THE PERIOD COVERED IN THIS CABLE, IT WILL BE LISTED UNDER THE DATE IT IS FIRST REPORTED PUBLICLY. THE ATTACK AGAINST THE NORTH KOREAN TRADE MISSION (REF 01), THE MURDER OF THREE POLICE OFFICERS IN A LIMA HOSPITAL (REF C1), THE BLACKOUT AND BOMBINGS IN LIMA (REF C1) AND THE ATTACK AGAINST A LIMA FACTORY AND TWO HIRING CAMPS (REF 01), HAVE ALL BEEN REPORTED SEPARATELY AND WILL BE MENTIONED ONLY BRIEFLY IN THIS CABLE. THE JOINT DECLARATION BY IENDERO LUPINDSO AND THE SPANISH COMMUNIST PARTY IS BEING REPORTED SEPTTEL.

- APRIL 30, 1987

- LIMA - TERRORISTS ATTACKED THE NORTH KOREAN COMMERCIAL MISSION, INJURING SEVERAL OF FIVE PEOPLE AND CAUSING SERIOUS DAMAGE TO THE BUILDING (REF 01).

- PUNO - THE PRESS REPORTED AN EIGHT-

- LA LIBERTAD - TERRORISTS OCCUPIED THE DISTRICT OF SANAGORAN, PROVINCE OF HUARACHUCO IN LA LIBERTAD ON MAY 29, REPORTEDLY PUBLICLY FLOODING THE MAYOR AND DEPUTY PREFECT AND BURNING THE TOWN HALL AND THE MAYOR'S HOME. ACCORDING TO PRESS REPORTS, BOTH OFFICIALS WERE TOLD TO RESIGN OR THEY WOULD BE KILLED.

- MAY 2

- LIMA - A POLICE STATION IN THE LIMA SUBURB OF IARATE WAS ATTACKED BY AN ESTIMATED FIVE TERRORISTS ARMED WITH AUTOMATIC WEAPONS AND EXPLOSIVES. POLICE FOUGHT OFF THE ATTACKERS WITHOUT INJURY AND LATER DEACTIVATED SEVERAL EXPLOSIVE DEVICES FOUND IN THE AREA. ACCORDING TO PRESS REPORTS, THE TERRORISTS HAD TRIED UNSUCCESSFULLY TO CAUSE A BLACKOUT IN THE AREA IMMEDIATELY BEFORE THE ATTACK.

- LIMA - FOUR TERRORISTS, DISGUISED IN MEDICAL UNIFORMS, ATTACKED THE DANIEL ALCIDES CARRION HOSPITAL IN THE PORT CITY OF CALLAO, KILLING THREE POLICE OFFICERS AND WOUNDING A FOURTH (REF C1).

- PUNO - UNKNOWN ASSAILANTS ATTACKED THE TOWN PARISH IN AZANGAR, PUNO, CAUSING DAMAGE TO THE CHURCH AND SURROUNDING BUILDINGS. ACCORDING TO PRESS REPORTS, A STICK OF DYNAMITE WAS THROWN INTO THE BEDROOM OF THE PARISH PRIEST, RONALD LLERENA, BUT HE WAS NOT INJURED. LLERENA HAS REPORTEDLY BEEN A HARSH CRITIC OF TERRORISTS AS WELL AS THE GOP. HIS PARISH WAS ATTACKED ONCE IN 1986, PUNO LEFTISTS AND CHURCH OFFICIALS BLAMED THE EARLIER ATTACK ON APR 08 POLICE MEMBERS.

- LIMA - POLICE CONDUCTED A MAJOR SWEEP IN VARIOUS LIMA NEIGHBORHOODS DETAINING APPROXIMATELY 1,000 PEOPLE TO CHECK FOR IDENTITY DOCUMENTS. ACCORDING TO PRESS REPORTS, ABOUT 85 PEOPLE ARE BEING HELD BY THE OFFICE OF STATE SECURITY FOR LACK OF DOCUMENTS.

- MAY 4

- LIMA - SUSPECTED SL TERRORISTS BLACKED OUT THE CITY AND STAGED A SERIES OF COORDINATED ATTACKS AGAINST GOVERNMENT, POLICE, MILITARY, AND FINANCIAL TARGETS. A 71-YEAR-OLD WOMAN DIED ON MAY 5 FROM THE WOUNDS SHE SUSTAINED WHILE SHE WAS HIT BY SHRAPNEL FROM ONE OF THE BOMBS (REF C1).

LIMA - TERRORISTS STRUCK TWO HIGH SCHOOL CAMPS IN THE MANTUANO AREA OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LIMA, STEALING 15 CASES OF DYNAMITE (100 STICKS IN EACH CASE) AND 500 BLASTING CAPS (REF 01).

LIMA - AN EXPLOSIVE DEVICE CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY 5 LBS. OF DYNAMITE WAS FOUND OUTSIDE A MINISTRY OF JUSTICE GARAGE. THE BOMB WAS DISARMED WITHOUT INJURY. POLICE SPECULATED THE DEVICE MAY HAVE BEEN LEFT THERE DURING THE MAY 4 ATTACKS BUT FAILED TO EXPLODE AND WAS NOT DISCOVERED UNTIL MAY 5.

LIMA - TERRORISTS FIREBOMBED A FACTORY OF THE BATA SHOE COMPANY (REF 01).

2. COMMENT: THE LEFTIST SENSATIONALIST "LA REPUBLICA" REPORTED THAT THE NEPHEW OF SLAIN APRA LEADER AND FORMER PRESIDENT OF CORDEJUNIO, FELIX ORTEGA ARCE, HAS BEEN ARRESTED AS A PRINCIPAL SUSPECT IN THE ASSASSINATION OF HIS UNCLE. THE NEPHEW, ODLANDO ORTEGA, IS BEING HELD BY THE PERUVIAN INVESTIGATIVE POLICE IN HUANCAYO. IT IS UNCLEAR WHETHER THE NEPHEW IS THOUGHT TO BE A MEMBER OF SL OR WHETHER THERE WERE OTHER MOTIVES FOR THE ASSASSINATION.
