1. TERRORISTS AGAIN BLACKED OUT LIMA AND
SEVERAL OTHER CITIES THE EVENING OF MAY 9,
STAGING A SERIES OF BOMBINGS AND ASSAULTS
AS SOON AS THE LIGHTS WENT OUT. THE BLACKOUTS
CAPPED AN INTENSE WEEK OF TERRORIST ACTIVITY
WHICH INCLUDED A MAJOR BLACKOUT AND COORDINATED
ATTACKS MAY 4 WFF AT AND ASSAULTS AGAINST
TWO FACTORIES MAY 5 AND 6.

2. THE MAY 9 ASSAULTS BEGAN JUST BEFORE
6 P.M. WHEN POWER WAS LOST IN ALL OF METRO-
POLITAN LIMA, AS WELL AS CITIES IN THE
DEPARTMENTS OF ICA, JUNIN, ANCASH, LA
LIBERTAD, AND LAMBAYEQUE. THE PRESS WAS
REPORTED AS MANY AS 20 BOMBINGS AGAINST
VARIED TARGETS, INCLUDING TWO UPRA OFFICES,
AN OPEN MARKET NEAR THE PRESIDENTIAL
PALACE, TWO POLICE STATIONS, AN OFFICE OF
THE GOVERNMENT TEMPORARY WORKERS PROJECT,
AND THE HEADQUARTERS OF MILITARY INDUSTRIES.
IN ADDITION, BOMBS WENT OFF UNDER A
PEDESTRIAN WALKWAY A BLOCK FROM THE
EMBASSY AND IN THE GENERAL AREA OF THE
MILITARY COMMAND ABOUT TWO BLOCKS FROM THE
AMBASSADOR'S RESIDENCE.

3. TWO TERRORISTS WERE BLOWN UP WHEN THE
BOMB THEY WERE REPORTEDLY TRYING TO USE AGAINST
A BRANCH OF BANCO CONTINENTAL EXPLODED IN
THEIR HANDS. THE TERRORISTS WERE IDENTI-
FIED AS TWO BROTHERS, FREDY AND RENE USTI
25 AND 21, RESPECTIVELY, BOTH OF LIMA.
THE OLDER BROTHER HAD BEEN ARRESTED IN
1983 ON TERRORIST CHARGES AND WAS RELEASED
IN 1985. HE WAS THOUGHT TO BE A MEMBER OF
