SUBJECT: PERU TERRORIST UPDATE JANUARY 14-20

THE FOLLOWING IS A LIST OF TERRORIST AND TERRORIST-RELATED REPORTS DURING THE WEEK BEGINNING JANUARY 14. WE COMPILED THE LIST FROM PRESS REPORTS, POST CONTACTS WITH PERU'S ANTI-TERRORIST POLICE UNIT (DIRECCION) AND DIRECCION INDEPENDENCIA, THE MILITARY JOINT COMMAND FOR THE STATE OF ORGANIZATION. THE INCIDENTS ARE LISTED UNDER THE DATE THEY ARE FIRST REPORTED. THE DATE OF THE INCIDENT, WHEN KNOWN, IS ALSO INCLUDED. TERRORIST ATTACKS THE NIGHT OF JANUARY 15 WERE COVERED IN REPORT #1.

1. 01 JANUARY 14, 1987

- TERRORISTS RAIDED AN OFFICE OF THE PERUVIAN LABOR MINISTRY AND A PRIVATE RESIDENCE JANUARY 13 IN CHIMBORIO. POLICE WERE ALSO ABLE TO DEFUSE A BOMB FOUND IN A COUNT-TOTAL SERVICE STATION THE SAME NIGHT.

- BOLIVIAN DEFENSE MINISTER LUIS FERNANDO VALLE CHAVEZ LA PAZ TUES JANUARY 13, 1987. ACCORDING TO THE BOLIVIAN PRESS, HE ESCAPED TO PREVENT THE CENTER OF MILITARY INFORMATION FROM CAPTURING HIM. ALSO, DIA AND DIA REPORTS THAT DIA IS INCREASING ITS ACTIVITY IN THE BOLIVIAN AREA.

- RESEARCHERS REPORT THAT A COORDINATED EFFORT BETWEEN DIA, DIA, AND DIA'S TRADITIONALLY LEFTIST FRIENDS, THE PEOPLE'S FRONT, AND THE PERUVIAN NATIONAL FRONT, HAS BEEN MADE TO DESTROY THE PERUVIAN ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM. THIS COULD BE ANOTHER EXAMPLE OF THE TERRORIST'S USE OF COMPUTER AND OTHER COMPUTER TECHNOLOGY TO DESTROY COMMUNICATIONS.

- ARMED TERRORISTS TOOK OVER RADIO MIRAFLORES IN THE

- A TERRORIST UNIT ATTACHED TWO TO THREE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF LA LIBERTAD JANUARY 15. THE TERRORISTS KILLED AT THE RESIDENCE OF A DISTRICT MAYOR, A POLICE OFFICER, AND A PHARMACY OWNED BY THE GOVERNOR. THE TERRORISTS LATER ATTACKED A MINING CAMP WHERE THEY KILLED 12 CASES OF DYNAMITE. ATTACKS AGAINST TRACTORS AND OTHER EQUIPMENT OWNED BY VARIOUS PUBLIC AGENCIES WERE ALSO REPORTED.

- JANUARY 15, 1987

- TERRORISTS ATTACKED A PUBLIC BUS IN TRUJILLO JANUARY 15. POLICE SAY TWO TERRORIST PASSENGERS WAITED UNTIL ALL OTHER PASSENGERS HAD DISEMBARKED AND THEN SET OFF A FIRE BOMB WHICH DID EXTENSIVE DAMAGE.

- TERRORISTS KILLED AN ARMY CAPTAIN JANUARY 14 AS HE WAS LEAVING HIS HOME IN HUANCAYO. WITNESSES SAID THREE GUNMAN WERE WAITING FOR THE VICTIM. PUBLIC RIVERA TORIBIO, HEAD OF THE HUANCAYO SECURITY OFFICE.

- WHILE SEARCHING FOR THE MURKED PUBLIC RIVERA, POLICE UNCOVERED AN MTA SAWHORSE. SUSPECTS WERE ARRESTED AND EXPLOSIVES AND PROPAGANDA KILLED.

- JANUARY 17, 1987

- DIRECCION ANNOUNCED THE ARREST OF AN UNKNOWN NUMBER OF 15 TERRORISTS WHO ALLEGEDLY HAD PLANS TO BOMB ADDITIONAL TEXTILE FACTORIES REPORTED BY

- NEWSPAPERS REPORTS SAY THAT IT WAS DETERMINED THAT THE LEADERS OF THE JUANITO TERRIBLE GROUP, REPORTEDLY 15 WERE FAMILY MEMBERS OF 15 TERRORISTS. ON JULY 11, IN THE PARISON UPRISING, THE WIDOW OF ANTONIO BIAZ

MARTINEZ, CATALINA LORENAZOS SANTIAGO AND CAMARADA MATTI, WAS IDENTIFIED AS THE OVERALL COORDINATOR OF THE ATTACK. THE TWO TERRORISTS KILLED DURING THE UPRISING HAVE BEEN IDENTIFIED AS STUDENTS AT UNIVIVERSITY OF CUSCO.

- JANUARY 18, 1987

- TERRORISTS IN HUANCAYO ATTACHED THE HOME OF VICTOR J. APOL, SECRETARY OF STATE, VICTOR J. APOL, AND VICTOR J. APOL, SON OF VICTOR J. APOL, SECRETARY OF STATE.

- TWO VEHICLES OF A TERRORIST GROUP CALLED "EL TERRIBLE GROUP" WERE CAPTURED JANUARY 18 IN CHIMBORIO. THEIR DRIVERS WHO ESCAPED WERE CAPTURED AND IDENTIFIED AS EL TERRIBLE AND ALBERTO TERRIBLE. THEY WERE KILLED IF THEY REFUSED.

- JANUARY 19, 1987

- A BOMB EXPLODED IN THE COURTYARD OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION IN LIMA JANUARY 19, 1987. NO INJURIES.

- A POLICE OFFICER AND HIS FRIENDLY SON DIED IN THE COURTYARD OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION IN LIMA JANUARY 19, 1987. NO INJURIES.

- REPORTS INDICATE THAT A TERRORIST GROUP CALLED "EL TERRIBLE GROUP" CAPTURED AND KILLED 10 MEMBERS OF THE POLICE IN LIMA JANUARY 19, 1987. NO INJURIES.

- AN ARMY CAPTAIN WAS KILLED BY THE REPORTEDLY REBELLIOUS
ARMED JANUARY 10 AS HEATE DURING A REBELLION. WITNESSES SAID A THREE-MAN K-9 GROUP WAS POLICE

- AN ESTIMATED 10 TERRORISTS WERE KILLED WHEN POLICE
ATTACKED AN SL SQUADRON IN THE TINGO MARIA AREA LAST
WEEK. THE ATTACK LEFT ONE POLICE OFFICER DEAD AND THREE
WOUNDED. POLICE SAY THE SL IS TAKING ADVANTAGE OF
PEASANT UNREST IN THE JUNGLE AREA, SURROUNDING A DEMAND
FOR HIGHER CROP PRICES, TO STEP UP ACTIVITY.
