(LIMA) - A BLACKOUT LEFT PART OF LIMA, INCLUDING THE AREA SURROUNDING THE PRESIDENTIAL PALACE, WITHOUT ELECTRICITY FOR SEVERAL HOURS BEGINNING AT APPROXIMATELY MIDNIGHT. ELECTRO-LIMA ATTRIBUTE THE BLACKOUT TO A TECHNICAL FAILURE (COMMENT: ALL BLACKOUTS IN LIMA ARE SUSPECT. SEE COMMENT).

(LIMA) - A TERRORIST COMPANY TO PRODUCE AT LEAST ONE MEMBER WEAPON TO A POLICE OFFICER. CONFIDENTIAL

ATTACKED THE PILSEN CALLAO BEER FACTORY, SETTING OFF SEVERAL BOMBS AND TAKING TWO EMPLOYEES HOSTAGE. ACCORDING TO PRESS REPORTS TEN TERRORISTS, INCLUDING THREE WOMEN, ARMED WITH HANDGUNS AND AUTOMATIC RIFLES, OVERPOWERED THE GUARDS TO ENTER, THEN THREATENED EMPLOYEES AND SET OFF THE BOMBS.

(CHOSICA) - A TRAIN CARRYING TONS OF ZINC ORE WAS BOMBED AND AT LEAST 50 METERS OF TRACK DESTROYED NEAR KILOMETER 42 OF THE CENTRAL HIGHWAY OUTSIDE OF CHOSICA. NEWSPAPER REPORTS QUOTE WITNESSES SAYING THAT TWO SUSPECTS WERE SEEN RUNNING FROM THE SITE.

(SUAREZ) - TERRORISTS BOMBED THE HOME OF AN AREA LEADER IN LLUPA, A SMALL TOWN OUTSIDE OF SUAREZ. THERE WAS DAMAGE BUT NO INJURIES.

(LIMA) - TERRORISTS ATTACKED A RACE TRACK IN SUBURBAN LIMA, SETTING OFF NUMEROUS EXPLOSIONS RESULTING IN THE DEATHS OF TWO VALUABLE RACE HORSES. THE ATTACK OCCURRED DURING A SUNDAY AFTERNOON RACE WITH 5,000 PEOPLE IN THE NEARBY STANDS. ONE OF THE HORSES WAS KILLED INSTANTLY BY AN EXPLOSION, AND A SECOND WAS LATER PUT TO SLEEP DUE TO INJURIES. THE TERRORISTS WERE SPECIFICALLY SEEKING TO KILL

"DALINO," ONE OF LATIN AMERICA'S BEST RACE HORSES, BUT WERE UNABLE TO LOCATE HIM. INITIAL REPORTS ATTRIBUTED THE ATTACK TO THE MIRA, BUT LATER COVERAGE NAMED SENOR... AS RESPONSIBLE. THE MIRA GROUP HAS PUBLICLY TAKEN RESPONSIBILITY.

(CUZCO) - POLICE FOUND 42 STICKS OF DYNAMITE IN SEVERAL DIFFERENT LOCATIONS IN A FERTILIZER PLANT IN CACHIMAYO, CUZCO, FOLLOWING A TELEPHONE BOMB THREAT. THE EXPLOSIVES WERE DEACTIVATED WITHOUT INJURY OR DAMAGE.
