(AYACUCHO) - PRESUMED SENDERO LUMINOZO (SL) TERRORISTS ATTACKED THE ARMY BARRACKS AT QUICAPATA, DEPARTMENT OF AYACUCHO, ON APRIL 7, KILLING TWO SOLDIERS. ACCORDING TO PRESS REPORTS, THE TERRORISTS STAGED A SNIPER ASSAULT AND THEN THREW EXPLOSIVES BEFORE BEING CHASED OFF. TWO SL MEMBERS, BEING HELD FOR KILLING A SOLDIER LAST MONTH, ARE REPORTEDLY JAILED AT THE BARRACKS.

(LIMA) - A POLICE OFFICER WAS KILLED BY A WOMAN TERRORIST WHO SHOT HIM WITH HIS OWN GUN

ABOARD AN INTER-DISTRICT BUS OUTSIDE OF IMPIRIAL IN THE DEPARTMENT OF LIMA. THE WOMAN REPORTEDLY ENGAGED THE OFFICER IN CONVERSATION THEN GRABBED HIS PISTOL AND SHOT HIM AT LEAST FOUR TIMES. ACCORDING TO PRESS ACCOUNTS, THERE WERE TWO OTHER TERRORISTS ABOARD THE BUS; AND ALL BEGAN YELLING REVOLUTIONARY SLOGANS, INCLUDING "THE DOGS WHO GUARD THE INTERESTS OF CAPITALISM WILL DIE LIKE THIS." THE VICTIM WAS ASSIGNED TO PARK GUARD DUTY.

(TRUJILLO) - TERRORISTS ATTACKED A POLICE STATION WITH DYNAMITE AND GUNFIRE. WITNESSES REPORTED THAT BEFORE THE ATTACK, SOME OF THE WALLS HAD BEEN PAINTED WITH MRTA-MIR PROPAGANDA. THE ASSAULT CAUSED DAMAGE TO THE BUILDING BUT NO INJURIES.

(CHIMBOIE) - A REPORTED TEN SUSPECTED TERRORISTS ATTACKED THE MINING CAMP OF PASTO FUENO, STEALING MONEY AND CLOTHING FROM THE MINERS AND PREACHING REVOLUTION. THE TERRORISTS WERE REPORTEDLY FRIGHTENED OFF BY A GROUP OF POLICE OFFICERS AND ESCAPED WITHOUT OBTAINING ANY EXPLOSIVES.

(CHICLAYO) - TERRORISTS STAGED A SECOND ATTACK AGAINST THE POLICE STATION AT PUEBLO RICO, OUTSIDE OF CHICLAYO, ~~THREE~~ THAN 48 HOURS AFTER AN ASSAULT WHICH LEFT TWO OFFICERS DEAD

AGAINST A LIMA RESTAURANT. ONE MAN WAS SERIOUSLY INJURED IN THE ATTACK; HIS MATE DIED, BRINGING THE ATTACK'S DEATH COUNT TO SEVEN.

- (LIMA) - TERRORISTS STAGED AN UNSUCCESSFUL ATTACK AGAINST A BRANCH OF INTERBANC, APPARENTLY INTENDED TO OCCUR SIMULTANEOUSLY WITH THE RESTAURANT ATTACK (REF B).

- (LA OROYA) - THE BRIDGE CROSSING THE MANTARO RIVER ON THE CENTRAL HIGHWAY, ABOUT 100 MILES OUTSIDE OF LA OROYA, WAS BLOWN UP BY TERRORISTS COMPLICATING TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM CERRO DE PASCO AND TINGO MARIA (REF B).

APRIL 12

- (LIMA) - A FEMALE POLICE OFFICER DIRECTING TRAFFIC IN DOWNTOWN LIMA WAS ATTACKED WITH GUNFIRE FROM A MOVING VEHICLE. SHE WAS NOT INJURED.

- (LIMA) - VARIOUS LIMA NEIGHBORHOODS WERE BLACKED OUT FOR SEVERAL HOURS. (COMMENT: THE BLACKOUT WAS ATTRIBUTED TO TECHNICAL FAILURES, BUT ANY BLACKOUT IN LIMA IS SUSPECT. END COMMENT.)

APRIL 11

- (IQCACHE) - TERRORISTS BLEW UP THE CITY HALL AND FORCED THE MAYOR AND ASSISTANT PREFECT TO LEAVE TOWN (REF C).

- (CUZCO) - TWO POLICE OFFICERS GUARDING A CUZCO TRAIN STATION WERE KILLED (REF D).

- (CHIMBOYE) - A BRAND NEW COMMUNITY TELEPHONE OFFICE WAS ATTACKED ON THE DAY IT WAS SCHEDULED TO BE DEDICATED. ACCORDING TO PRESS REPORTS, WHICH ATTRIBUTE THE ASSAULT TO THE MRTA, TERRORISTS USED SEVERAL BOMBS.

(LIMA) - POLICE ANNOUNCED THE DISCOVERY OF A TERRORIST EXPLOSIVE CACHE IN THE LOWER CLASS NEIGHBORHOOD OF SAN MARTIN DE PORRES. A REPORTED 1,500 STICKS OF DYNAMITE WERE RECOVERED AND ONE PERSON ARRESTED.

(APURIMAC) - SUSPECTED SL TERRORISTS ATTACKED A POLICE STATION IN ANDAHUAYLAS, APURIMAC, OVERPOWERING TEN POLICE OFFICERS, TYING THEM UP, AND STEALING THE STATION'S ARSENAL, INCLUDING 15 MACHINE GUNS AND TEN GRENADES. ACCORDING TO PRESS REPORTS, THE

(IUNO) - A BOMB EXPLODED IN THE MAIN ENTRANCE OF A BANCO DE CREDITO OFFICE IN IUNO CAUSING DAMAGE BUT NO INJURIES. ACCORDING TO PRESS REPORTS, WALLS NEAR THE BANK WERE PAINTED WITH MRTA-MIR SLOGANS.

(TRUJILLO) - TWO BOMBS WERE FOUND ON THE SECOND FLOOR OF A BRANCH OF THE BANCO DE LA NACION. BOTH WERE DISARMED WITHOUT INCIDENT.

(LIMA) - PRESUMED TERRORISTS ATTACKED AN OFFICIAL OF THE STATE RICE MARKETING ENTERPRISE, WOUNDING HIM IN THE HEAD. ACCORDING TO PRESS REPORTS, THE VICTIM, JOSE PAREDES, WAS SHOT OUTSIDE HIS HOME, IMMEDIATELY AFTER BEING DROPPED OFF BY HIS BROTHER WHO IS A POLICE CAPTAIN. POLICE SPECULATE HIS ASSAILANTS MAY HAVE CONFUSED HIM WITH HIS BROTHER.

PRISON RIGHTS APPROACH. SL IS CLEARLY ADAPTING THE STRATEGY OF SURPRISE AND VIOLENCE TO GAIN ACCESS TO ITS VICTIMS. IN ADDITION TO THE POLICE UNIFORMS SL HAS BEEN USING, THIS WEEK MEMBERS ALSO PRESENTED THEMSELVES AS STUDENTS, STREET PREACHERS AND RANCHERS, ALL WITH DISMAYING SUCCESS. THE NUMBER OF TERRORIST INCIDENTS IN HUARAZ IS INCREASING AND IS AT LEAST PARTIALLY DIRECTED AGAINST THE TOWN'S TOURISM INDUSTRY. HUARAZ IS AN ESPECIALLY POPULAR DESTINATION DURING EASTER WEEK. LINCOTE HAS ANNOUNCED THAT ONE OF THE SUSPECTS ARRESTED IN CONNECTION WITH THE BIAS OF BANK BOMBINGS IN LIMA, GLADYS CAROL ESPINOZA GONZALES, 33, LIVED IN THE SOVIET UNION FOR EIGHT YEARS AND STUDIED LAW AT THE UNIVERSITY OF KIEV.
