ICAJAMARCA - THE MRTA IS SUSPECTED IN THREE CAJAMARCA
BOMBINGS INCLUDING ATTACKS AGAINST THE DEPARTMENTAL
DIRECTOR OF EDUCATION, ALEJANDRO REBACA MARTEL, AND THE
FORMER PRESIDENT OF THE SUPERIOR COURT, DR. PEDRO IBERICO
RAS. THE THIRD BOMBING OCCURRED IN THE TOWN PLAZA NO
INJURIES WERE REPORTED. ACCORDING TO NEWSPAPER REPORTS,
THE BOMBINGS WERE RELATED TO RECENT CLASHES BETWEEN
APRISTAS AND COMMUNISTS AT THE TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY OF
CAJAMARCA.

LIMA - POLICE DEACTIVATED A CAR BOMB FOUND IN THE
PARKING LOT IN THE LIMA SUBURB OF MARANGA. ACCORDING
TO PRESS REPORTS, POLICE LOCATED THE CAR, WHICH HAD
PREVIOUSLY BEEN REPORTED STOLEN, BECAME SUSPICIOUS AND
ALERTED THE BOMB SQUAD.

ICRIMBOTI - A PROFESSOR WAS SHOT AND SERIOUSLY WOUNDED
AT THE PRIVATE LOS ANGELES UNIVERSITY. ACCORDING TO PRESS
REPORTS, TERRORISTS BROKE INTO THE PROFESSOR'S OFFICE
AND OPENED FIRE WITH AUTOMATIC WEAPONS AT POINT-BLANK
RANGE. A SHORT TIME LATER, SEVERAL MEMBERS OF THE MEDIA
REPORTEDLY RECEIVED COMMUNIQUE FROM THE MRTA TAKING
RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE ATTACK AND DEMANDING THAT LOCAL
OFFICIALS RESIGN.

MOCHIZO - A REPORTED 20 TERRORISTS WERE KILLED BY
POLICE FORCES SECURING THE TOWN OF MOCHIZO. ANOTHER 50
SUSPECTED TERRORISTS WERE DETAINED IN THE NEARBY
TOWN OF PAMPAYACO DURING THE SAME OPERATION DUBBED
"BRONCO ONE."

JUNE 19, 1987

IMPURIMAC - THREE TERRORISTS WERE KILLED AND FOUR OTHERS
CAPTURED BY A POLICE PATROL IN ANDRIMAC. JOURNALS IN
OFFICIAL ANNOUNCEMENT BY THE MINISTRY OF INTERIOR SAID
THE PATROL WAS SENT TO THE AREA AFTER INTELLIGENCE WORK
UNCOVERED THE EXISTENCE OF A TERRORIST GROUP THERE

IMPURIMAC - NINETEEN CAMPESINOS WERE KILLED BY
TERRORISTS IN THE LA MAR PROVINCE OF SHACHTO FOLLOWING
A "PEOPLE'S TRIAL." ACCORDING TO PRESS ACCOUNTS,
TRAVELLERS FROM THE AREA REPORT ABOUT 50 SUBVERSIVES
INTERCEPTED SEVERAL BOATS ON THE APURIMAC RIVER AND
FORCED THEM ASHORE. THE 19 VICTIMS, MEMBERS OF A PEASANT
MILITIA, WERE ACCUSED OF BEING INFORMERS AND EXECUTED
IN FRONT OF RESIDENTS IN THE VILLAGE OF SANBARI.
OTHER NEWS REPORTS INDICATED THE PEASANTS WERE KILLED
BECAUSE THEY HAD CONTRIBUTED TO THEIR CAPTURE. THE
COMMUNIST GROUP REPORTEDLY ATTACKED THE TOWN OF
SAN FRANCISCO AND SANTA ROSA, KIDNAPPING SEVEN TRADERS
WHO ARE FEARED DEAD.

1. THE FOLLOWING IS A LIST OF TERRORIST AND
TERRORIST-RELATED INCIDENTS FOR THE WEEK BEGINNING
JUNE 17. WE COMPILED THE LIST FROM PRESS REPORTS,
CONTACTS WITH PERU'S ANTI-TERRORISM POLICE UNIT (DIRCOTE)
AND OFFICIAL ANNOUNCEMENTS BY THE MILITARY JOINT COMMAND.
WHEN THE DATE OF THE INCIDENT IS UNKNOWN OR BEFORE THE
PERIOD COVERED IN THIS CABLE, IT WILL BE LISTED UNDER THE
DATE IT IS FIRST REPORTED PUBLICLY. EVENTS SURROUNDING
THE JUNE 18-19 ANNIVERSARY OF THE PRISON RIOTS, INCLUDING
SEVERAL LUMINOUS PARTICIPATION AT A SAN MARCOS UNIVERSITY
BALLY AND AN ANNOUNCEMENT BY INTERIOR MINISTER ABEL SALINAS
WARNING OF IMPENDING TERRORIST ATTACKS, WERE REPORTED
SEPARATELY.

JUNE 17, 1987

MAREQUIPA - A CAR BOMB EXPLODED OUTSIDE A MILITARY
HEADQUARTERS CAUSING DAMAGE TO THE BUILDING AND BREAKING
WINDOWS IN THE AREA. NO INJURIES WERE REPORTED
ACCORDING TO PRESS ACCOUNTS, THE CAR HAD BEEN STOLEN
FROM A TAXI DRIVER ABOUT TWO HOURS BEFORE THE ATTACK.
THE MRTA REPORTEDLY TOOK CREDIT FOR THE ATTACK IN A LETTER
LEFT AT AN MAREQUIPA RADIO STATION.

MUNICHCHI - FOUR MOLTOV COCKTAILS EXPLODED JUNE 16 IN
ARENAS OF THE NATIONAL UNIVERSITY JOSE FAUSTINO SANJES
CARRION DURING REGISTRATION FOR A STUDENT ELECTION.
DAMAGES OR INJURIES WERE REPORTED.

ICRIMBOTI - TERRORISTS BOMBED THE HOME OF LUCICHICO
MONTANEZ, HEAD OF THE PUBLIC REGISTRY. ACCORDING TO
NEWS REPORTS, MONTANEZ WAS INJURED IN THE ATTACK.
