DEAR SENATOR BOSEKWIITZ:

THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE HAS REFERRED TO US YOUR LETTER OF JUNE 12 IN WHICH YOU DISCUSSED THE CONCERN OF YOUR CONSTITUENTS,

REGARDING THE INSTITUTE FOR RURAL STUDIES (INSTITUTO DE ESTUDIOS RURALES) IN AYAVIRI, PERU (OFFICE FILE NO. 7161038026). YOUR CONSTITUENTS WERE PARTICULARLY CONCERNED ABOUT REPORTS THAT THE INSTITUTE HAD BEEN THREATENED BY THE SHINING PATH GUERRILLA GROUP, AS WELL AS BY LOCAL AUTHORITIES.

THE INSTITUTE FOR RURAL STUDIES IS LOCATED IN THE COUNTRYSIDE NEAR THE TOWN OF AYAVIRI IN THE CONFLICT-RIDDEN DEPARTMENT OF PUNG, IN SOUTHERN PERU. IT IS OPERATED BY THE CATHOLIC PRELATURE OF AYAVIRI. SECURITY CONDITIONS RESTRICT FREQUENT TRAVEL TO THE AREA, AND COMMUNICATIONS ARE NOT GOOD. THE INSTITUTE HAS NO TELEPHONE, AND OUR EFFORTS TO CONTACT IT THROUGH THE AYAVIRI PRELATURE WERE UNSUCCESSFUL. HOWEVER, WE HAVE BEEN ABLE TO GET INFORMATION ABOUT THE INSTITUTE'S SITUATION FROM REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NEAREST PUNG HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION, THE PUNG PREFECT (CENTRAL GOVERNMENT REPRESENTATIVE IN THE AREA), AND THE HUMAN RIGHTS OFFICE OF THE LIMA-BASED EPISCOPAL SOCIAL ACTION COMMISSION. BOTH HUMAN RIGHTS GROUPS ARE IN FREQUENT TOUCH WITH THE INSTITUTE.

ALL THREE ORGANIZATIONS AGREED THAT THE THREAT FROM THE SHINING PATH WAS REAL -- THREATS HAD BEEN MADE IN EARLY 1987 -- BUT HAD NOT MATERIALIZED. THEY ALSO AGREED THAT THE SHINING PATH'S PRESENCE IN THE AREA HAD DECREASED SINCE EARLY 1987. THE PUNG PREFECT DENIED THAT LOCAL AUTHORITIES HAD THREATENED THE INSTITUTE. THE TWO HUMAN RIGHTS GROUPS CLAIMED TO BE UNAWARE

OF A THREAT TO THE INSTITUTE BY LOCAL AUTHORITIES. THE PUNG PREFECT DENIED THE THREAT, BUT STATED THAT PUNG POLICE AND OTHER LOCAL GROUPS CALLED ATTENTION TO A RECENT COVERT MEETING BETWEEN THE HEAD OF THE INSTITUTE AND THE GENERAL IN CHARGE OF PUNG POLICE FORCES, BASED ON WHICH IT APPEARED THAT THE INSTITUTE HAD NORMAL RELATIONS WITH THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES. HE, OF COURSE, MADE CLEAR TO THE HUMAN RIGHTS GROUPS AND THE PUNG PREFECT OUR CONCERN FOR RESPECT FOR HUMAN RIGHTS AND THE CONTINUED SAFETY OF THE INSTITUTE.
