CONTRABAND - TERRORISTS KILLED THREE OFFICERS
AND INJURED FOUR ACCORDING TO NEWSPAPER
REPORTS. THE ASSAULT, WHICH LASTED FOR ALMOST
FIVE HOURS, WAS REPORTEDLY USED
AUTOMATIC WEAPONS AND EXPLOSIVES BUT WERE
HELD OFF BY 10 OFFICERS INSIDE THE STATION

JULY 11

MATACUCHO - THREE ADULT COMPETITORS WERE
KILLED AND TWO YOUTHS INJURED DURING AN ATTACK
AGAINST THE VILLAGE OF MATACUCHO. ACCORDING
TO PRESS REPORTS, THE THREE MURDER VICTIMS
WERE TAKEN FROM THEIR HOMES AND EXECUTED.
THE TERRORISTS THEN TRIED TO KIDNAP THE
YOUTHS, THEY RESISTED AND WERE SHOT, BUT BOTH
SURVIVED.

MATACUCHO - AN EMPLOYEE OF COOPERACION
POPULAR, RIGHAPPED JULY 3 FROM THE COOPOP
HEADQUARTERS IN MURCAPI, WAS FOUND DEAD.
THE VICTIM, PETER PANASUA VENADO, HAD BEEN
THE AGENCY'S LOCAL ACCOUNTANT.

JULY 12

MINCASH - SUSPECTED TERRORISTS TORCHED
A TOURIST HOSTEL NEAR THE FAMOUS LAGOONS
OF LEANGUERO. THE BLAZE DESTROYED A LARGE
PORTION OF THE STRUCTURE, BUT THERE WERE NO
INJURIES.

CERRO DE PASCO - TERRORISTS BOMBED
EIGHT SEPARATE TARGETS IN CERRO DE PASCO,

CAUSING EXTENSIVE DAMAGE AND LEAVING THE
CITY WITHOUT WATER. THE TARGETS INCLUDED
THE TOWN'S WATER PUMPS, A BRANCH OF BANCO
CENTRAL DE COOPERATIVO, AND SEVERAL MUNICIPAL
BUILDINGS. THE ATTACK AGAINST THE WATER
PUMPS ALSO SHUT DOWN SOME OPERATIONS AT
CENTROMIN, THE STATE MINING COMPANY WHICH
DEPENDS ON WATER FROM THE SAME SYSTEM.

JULY 13

CHINCHILLA - TERRORISTS KILLED AT LEAST
THREE HIGH-TENSION COVERS, BLACKING OUT PARTS
OF HUANTA AND AYACUCHO.

JULY 14

CHINCHILLA - A TERRORIST ABOARD AN INTER-
PROVINCIAL BUS TRAVELING BETWEEN CHINCHILLA
AND LIMA, KILLED A POLICE OFFICER AND HIS
CIVILIAN COMPANION. ACCORDING TO PRESS
REPORTS, THE TERRORIST USED A REVOLVER
AND SHOT THE VICTIMS FROM BEHIND. HE THEN
PILLED UP THE VICTIMS AND FORCED THE
BUS DRIVER TO TURN OVER, AND JUMPED OUT.

1. AND THE FOLLOWING IS A LIST OF
TERRORIST AND TERRORIST-RELATED INCIDENTS
FOR THE WEEK BEGINNING JUNE 8. WE COMPILED
THE LIST FROM PRESS REPORTS, CONTACTS WITH
PERU'S ANTI-TERRORISM POLICE UNIT (CICOTER),
AND OFFICIAL ANNOUNCEMENTS BY THE MILITARY
JOINT COMMAND. WHEN THE DATE OF THE INCIDENT
IS UNKNOWN OR BEFORE THE PERIOD COVERED IN
THIS REPORT, IT WILL BE LISTED UNDER THE DATE
IT IS FIRST REPORTED PUBLICLY.

JULY 8, 1987

CERRO DE PASCO - A POLICE OFFICER WAS
SHOT AND KILLED ABOUT FOUR BLOCKS FROM CITY
HALL. ACCORDING TO PRESS REPORTS, THREE
SUSPECTS APPROACHED THE VICTIM, SANTOS
DIAZ ARTEAGA, AND OPENED FIRE WITHOUT
WARNING. THE SAME EVENING, TERRORISTS SET
OFF NUMEROUS EXPLOSIONS IN THE AREA OF
COLLARIQUICURA, ABOUT 20 KMS FROM CERRO DE
PASCO, BLOWING UP POWER LINES AND DAMAGING
A COAL MINE.

- LIMA - THE DIRECTOR OF THE "JOSE CARLOS
MARIAATEGUI" SCHOOL IN THE LOWER CLASS NEIGH-
BORHOOD OF EL AGUSTINO REVEALED THAT HIS SCHOOL
HAD BEEN ROBBED BY THE MRTA THE NIGHT OF JUNE 12.
THE TERRORISTS ALLEGEDLY TOOK ASSORTED
EQUIPMENT. THE DIRECTOR ALSO COMPLAINED
ABOUT THE LACK OF INTEREST EXPRESSED IN THE
ROBBERY BY AUTHORITIES.

- SAN MARTIN - PORTIONS OF THE DEPARTMENTS
OF SAN MARTIN AND HUANUCO WERE DECLARED STATES
OF EMERGENCY FOR 60 DAYS. IN SAN MARTIN,
THE AFFECTED AREA INCLUDES THE PROVINCE OF
TOCACHE WHERE DRUG TRAFFICKERS AND SUSPECTED
TERRORISTS HAD PREVIOUSLY REDUCED THE AREA TO
LAWLESSNESS. THE DECREE, PUBLISHED IN "EL
PERUANO" JULY 19, SUSPENDS CONSTITUTIONAL
GUARANTEES IN THE REGION AND PUTS THE MINISTRY
OF INTERIOR IN CHARGE OF THE ZONE. SEE LIMA 0032

CONTINUED INVESTIGATIONS FOLLOWING THE ARREST
OF SL CUZCO LEADER WALTER VICTOR PALACIOS
SIERRALTA (REF. 01) UNCOVERED ALLEGED PLANS TO
BOMB A SERIES OF CUZCO NIGHTCLUBS FREQUENTED BY
TOURISTS. WITH THE ARRESTS IN CUZCO, WHICH
INCLUDED MEMBERS OF TWO SEPARATE SENDERO CELLS,
POLICE SAY 80 PERCENT OF THE AREA'S TERRORIST
CRIMES HAVE BEEN SOLVED. IN ANOTHER APPARENT
VICTORY FOR CUZCO POLICE, AN ARCHITECT ON THE
GOVERNMENT PAYROLL HAS ALSO BEEN ARRESTED IN

CONNECTION WITH SENDERO ACTIVITY. JULIO HERMAN
VASQUEZ CONDORINA, AN EMPLOYEE OF COPESCO
(A TOURISM DEVELOPMENT ORGANIZATION), WAS
ARRESTED EARLIER THIS MONTH WHEN HE PICKED UP
A PACKAGE CONTAINING WEAPONS, PROPAGANDA, AND
MEDICINE THAT HAD BEEN SHIPPED TO HIM FROM LIMA.
A RAID AT VASQUEZ' HOME TURNED UP ADDITIONAL
WEAPONS AND PROPAGANDA.

POLICE HAVE ARRESTED 26 STUDENTS AT THE
ALCIDES CARRION UNIVERSITY IN CERRO DE PASCO
FOLLOWING THE TERRORIST ATTACKS THERE THIS
WEEK. FIDEL BERNARDO SABUCO, SECRETARY
GENERAL OF THE STUDENT FEDERATION, WAS AMONG
THOSE ARRESTED.

A NEWSPAPER ARTICLE JULY 14 DATEDLINE BOGOTA
REPORTS THE ARREST OF JULIO RODERO, IDENTIFIED
BY COLOMBIAN POLICE AS A MEMBER OF SL. HE WAS
ARRESTED WITH ANSELMO TORRES, IDENTIFIED AS AN
M-19 MEMBER. THE TWO WERE IN POSSESSION OF
20 CASES OF DYNAMITE, 54 REVOLVERS, AN RPG-7,
AND FUSES AND BLASTING CAPS. THEY WERE ARRESTED
IN SOUTHERN COLOMBIA AS THEY REPORTEDLY TOOK
TO ENTER ECUADOR WITH THE EXPLOSIVES.

EDMUND COX BENIZVILLE, ARRESTED EARLIER THIS
YEAR IN LIMA AS A SENDERO LEADER, HAS BEEN FOUND

PERUVIAN
AUTHORITIES SAY THEY HAVE NO INFORMATION ON
THE PERUVIAN TERRORIST ARRESTED IN COLOMBIA.
SENDERO AS AN ORGANIZATION IS NOT USUALLY
BELIEVED TO HAVE LINKS WITH OTHER TERRORIST
GROUPS, BUT THE POSSIBILITY ALWAYS EXISTS.
THE CONSERVATIVE DAILY "EXPRESSO" ran a free-
lance article done by a PERUVIAN JOURNALIST
LIVING IN SWEDEN THAT DETAILED SENDERO
ACTIVITY THERE. IT INCLUDED INFORMATION ON
A CAMPAIGN AGAINST THE WRITINGS OF RABIO
VARGAS LLOSA.
