1. THE FOLLOWING IS A LIST OF TERRORIST AND TERRORIST-RELATED INCIDENTS FOR THE WEEK BEGINNING AUGUST 12. WE COMPILED THE LIST FROM PRESS REPORTS, CONTACTS WITH PERU'S ANTI-TERRORISM POLICE UNIT (DIRECOTEL), AND OFFICIAL ANNOUNCEMENTS BY THE GOV. WHEN THE DATE OF THE INCIDENT IS UNKNOWN OR BEFORE THE PERIOD COVERED IN THIS CABLE, IT WILL BE LISTED UNDER THE DATE IT IS FIRST REPORTED PUBLICLY. THE ARREST OF SIX SUSPECTED PRTA TERRORISTS WAS REPORTED IN REF B.

• AUGUST 17, 1987

- (CHIMBORAZO) - TERRORISTS USED EXPLOSIVES TO ATTACK A POLICE STATION IN THE CHIMBORAZO, "PUEBLO JOVEN" OF ALTO PERU. THE SUSPECTS ALSO PAINTED NEARBY WALLS WITH SUBVERSIVE SLOGANS AND LEFT PROPAGANDA AT THE SCENE. ACCORDING TO NEWSPAPER ACCOUNTS, BLOOD STAINS WERE FOUND NEAR THE POLICE STATION LEADING TO SPECULATION THAT ONE OF THE TERRORISTS HAD BEEN INJURED BY POLICE FIRE.

• **Bomb** - Police discovered a car bomb found at a site 1700' feet from the Plaza de Armas. The car bomb, which contained approximately 10 lbs. of dynamite, was apparently left at the scene several hours before it was discovered.

- SHANGAYON - AN ESTIMATED 30 MEMBERS OF SENDERO LUMINOSO TOOK OVER THE HACIENDA "ARMA" IN THE DISTRICT OF PARAHUANCO, BURNING DOWN THE MAIN HOUSE AND GIVING AWAY 300 HEAD OF CATTLE TO CAMPESINOS IN THE AREA. ACCORDING TO PRESS REPORTS, THE TERRORISTS RECEIVED SOME SUPPORT FROM CAMPESINOS WHO WERE GATHERED AT THE HACIENDA TO ACCEPT THE CATTLE.

- MUYACUCHO - A LOCAL GOVERNMENT OFFICIAL IN MUYALLAO, TAMBO DISTRICT, LA RAR, ATACUCHO, WAS EXECUTED BY A BAND OF SL SUBVERSIVES WHO INVADED THE VILLAGE. ACCORDING TO PRESS REPORTS, APPROXIMATELY 15 SUBVERSIVES FORCED THE TOWNSPEOPLE INTO THE MAIN PLAZA, THEN DRAGGED THE VICTIM, GUALBERTO MARTINEZ CABRERA, FROM HIS HOME AND SHOT HIM SEVERAL TIMES.

- (MANABEQUE) - TERRORISTS ASSASSINATED THE SUB-PREFECT OF FERREIRA IN HIS GOVERNMENT HEADQUARTERS OFFICE. THE VICTIM, CESAR SOLIS BARRAGAN, WAS ALSO PROVINCIAL SECRETARY OF THE APRA PARTY. ACCORDING TO PRESS REPORTS, TWO SUSPECTS ENTERED THE PREFECTURA WITH WEAPONS HIDDEN UNDER THEIR COATS. ONE OF THEM STAYED IN THE OFFICE TO KEEP THE SECRETARY FROM CALLING FOR HELP WHILE THE SECOND ENTERED THE VICTIM'S

OFFICE AND KILLED GIRL. THE ATTACK WAS ATTRIBUTED TO BOTH THE PATA AND SENDERO BY VARIOUS NEWSPAPERS. SENDERO INVOLVEMENT APPEARS MORE LIKELY.

BIRAI - SUSPECTED TERRORISTS BEAT THE 68-YEAR-OLD MOTHER OF A JUDGE WHO PRESIDES OVER TERRORIST CASES. THE VICTIM, LIDIA SAN MIQUEL DE MARILLA, MOTHER OF JUDGE RUBEN MARILLA, WAS FOUND IN HER HOME WITH SERIOUS INJURIES AND IN A COMA.

- AUGUST 14

AYACUCHO - THE CHIEF OF A RURAL MEDICAL POST AND A LEGAL ADVISOR TO THE LOCAL LAND REFORM OFFICE WERE KILLED BY SL TERRORISTS WHO AMBUSHED THE AMBULANCE IN WHICH THEY WERE RIDING. ACCORDING TO PRESS REPORTS, THE VICTIMS, SAURON BENETRIO YNOA BILMEZO AND JETHING MORALES CHICHICHTHU, WERE RAISING MONEY TO REINFORCE AN APPROPRIATE GROUP AGAINST THE TERRORISTS.

- GIBAL - A RETIRED AIR FORCE COLONEL WAS SHOT AND SERIOUSLY WOUNDED OUTSIDE A PIZZA PARLOR IN THE UPPER-CLASS NEIGHBORHOOD OF MIRAFLORES. THE VICTIM, FAUSTO GUERRA ORTIZ, WAS RETURNING TO HIS VEHICLE WHEN THE ASSAILANTS OPENED FIRE WITH AUTOMATIC WEAPONS, HITTING HIM FOUR TIMES. GUERRA IS STILL HOSPITALIZED IN SERIOUS CONDITION.

- YACUCHO - ONE SOLDIER AND THREE TERRORISTS WERE KILLED IN A CLASH BETWEEN THE ARMY AND A TERRORIST GROUP IN CUCUNHUASI, APPROXIMATELY 30 KMS NORTHEAST OF YACUCHO.

August 16

- MATACUCHO - TERRORISTS BLEW UP A TRUCK IN THE SAN JUAN Bautista DISTRICT OF MATACUCHO. THE BLAST ALSO BROKE WINDOWS IN THE AREA AND KNOCKED OUT A POWER LINE ACCORDING TO PRESS REPORTS. THE TRUCK BELONGED TO A PROSPEROUS MERCHANT.

- QUARUQUOI - A REPORTED ISO SUBVERSIVES INTERRUPTED A SUNDAY FESTIVAL IN QUARUQUO AND SUBJECTED PEOPLE IN THE TOWN SQUARE TO A THREE-HOUR IndoctrINATION SESSION. ACCORDING TO PRESS REPORTS, THE SUSPECTED MEMBERS OF A COMMUNIST MERCHANT

- MUANUCO - A REPORTED 150 SUBVERSIVES INTERRUPTED A S DAY FESTIVAL IN MUANUCO AND SUBJECTED PEOPLE IN THE TOWN SQUARE TO A THREE-HOUR INDOCTRINATION SESSION. ACCORDING TO PRESS REPORTS, THE SUSPECTED EL MEMBERS, ARMED WITH GUNS AND STICKS, ALSO ABUSED A UNITED LEFT STUDENT GROUP WHICH WAS CONDUCTING A RALLY CONCERNING UPCOMING STUDENT ELECTIONS.

- AUGUST 17

0 - HUANCAYA-PILOC - A BRIDGE NEARING COMPLETION CLOSE TO THE HUANCAYA-PILOC HIGHWAY WAS ATTACKED BY SUSPECTED SENDERO SUBVERSIVES WHO FORCED WORKERS AT THE SITE TO EARN THE SUPPORT STRUCTURES AND DUMP BUILDING MATERIALS INTO THE RIVER. THE BRIDGE WAS A BRIDGE SPANNING THE RIVER.

- BURGAS - A WORKHOUSE OF THE CRISTAL BEER BREWERY IN BURGAS WAS BOMBED BY FOUR SUSPECTS. THE BLAST CAUSES NO INJURIES AND ONLY SLIGHT DAMAGE.

- BOMBING - ACCORDING TO NEWSPAPER REPORTS, THE MATA IS SUSPECTED IN THE AUGUST 16 BOMBING OF THE BANCO ALLARDO DE SATIPO WHICH CAUSED SERIOUS DAMAGE BUT NO APPARENT INJURIES.

- QUITO - THE GOVERNMENT EXTENDED THE STATE OF EMERGENCY IN LIMA AND CALLED FOR ANOTHER 30 DAYS. ON JULY 28, PRESIDENT GARCIA LIFTED THE 1 A.M. TO 5 A.M. CURFEW, BUT SUSPENSION OF CERTAIN CONSTITUTIONAL GUARANTEES IN THE LIMA METROPOLITAN AREA CONTINUES.
