
1. (U) PRESUMED SENDERO LUMINOSO (SL) TERRORISTS HAVE STEPPED UP ATTACKS IN URBAN AREAS DURING THE PAST 10 DAYS.

-- ON SEPTEMBER 13, GUNMEN ASSASSINATED TWO POLICEMEN GUARDING AN "EL COMERCIO" NEWSPAPER FACILITY IN THE CONFIDENTIAL CONFIDENTIAL

RETURNED FROM DUTY IN THE AYACUCHO EMERGENCY ZONE.

- -- ALSO ON SEPTEMBER 13, A 14 YEAR OLD BOY DIED IN AYACUCHO WHEN A DYNAMITE CHARGE HE WAS CARRYING EXPLODED PREMATURELY. IDENTIFIED AS LUIS CHOCCE, THE BOY DIED NEAR A POLICE STATION WHICH MAY HAVE BEEN HIS INTENDED TARGET.
- -- ON SEPTEMBER 18, AN EXPLOSION DAMAGED PART OF THE TRANSANDEAN OIL PIPELINE (REF A), LOCATED IN NORTHERN PERU. THE PIPELINE WAS REPAIRED ON SEPTEMBER 21.
- -- ON SEPTEMBER 19, TERRORISTS BOMBED ELECTRICAL TRANSMISSION TOWERS AND A POLICE STATION IN A SLUM AREA OF THE NORTHERN CITY OF CHIMBOTE. NO CASUALITIES WERE REPORTED.
- -- ON SEPTEMBER 19, SEVERAL EXPLOSIONS REPORTEDLY OCCURRED IN AYACUCHO; NO CASUALTIES WERE REPORTED.
- AT DAEPTEMBER 20, PRESUMED SL MEMBERS EXPLODED A CAR BOMB AT THE ENTRANCE TO THE CALLAO NAVAL AIR BASE, WOUNDING ONE NAVAL OFFICER AND ONE PASSERBY. UNLIK PREVIOUS CAR BOMBS WHICH USED STATIONARY VEHICLES, INITIAL REPORTS STATE TERRORISTS POINTED THE CAR AT THE ENTRANCE AND LEPT OUT OF IT WHILE IT WAS MOVING.
- -- AT 8:00 P.M. SEPTEMBER 20, TERRORISTS BLEW UP ELECTRICAL TRANSMISSION TOWERS IN THE SANTA EULALIA VALLEY, CAUSING A BLACKOUT IN LIMA AND NEIGHBORING TOWNS FOR ABOUT 40 MINUTES. DURING THE BLACKOUT, TWO ATTACKS WERE REPORTED AGAINST POLICE CONFIDENTIAL

STATIONS IN THE LIMA SLUM OF EL AGUSTINO. ONE PEDESTRIAN WAS REPORTEDLY WOUNDED WHEN POLICE RETURNED FIRE.

- -- ALSO ON SEPTEMBER 20, AN ARMY SERGEANT REPORTEDLY DIED IN AN SL AMBUSH IN LA MAR PROVINCE, AYACUCHO DEPARTMENT.
- -- ON SEPTEMBER 21, POLICE REPORTEDLY FOUND AND DEACTIVATED TWO EXPLOSIVE DEVICES LEFT ON THE RAILROAD

- 2. (U) THESE EVENTS CONTRASTED WITH LACK OF REPORTED ACTIVITY—ARMED OR PROPAGANDA—BY THE TUPAC AMARU REVOLUTIONARY MOVEMENT. HOWEVER, ON SEPTEMBER 21, POLICE CAPTURED JOSE CARAZAS YABAR AS HE PREPARED TO BOARD A FLIGHT TO CUZCO: CARAZAS REPORTEDLY WAS CARRYING MRTA LITERATURE AND SEVERAL HUNDRED ROUNDS OF 9MM AMMUNITION.
- 3. (C) COMMENT: SL ACTIVITY GENERALLY IS CYCLICAL, SO CURRENT SPATE OF ATTACKS IS NOT UNUSUAL IN ITSELF. THERE ARE, HOWEVER, TWO INTERESTING FEATURES ABOUT THESE ATTACKS. FIRST IS THE INCREASE IN ACTIVITY IN THE CITY OF AYACUCHO, WHICH SECURITY FORCES HAD MANAGED TO KEEP LARGELY FREE OF INCIDENTS FORCES HAD MANAGED TO KEEP LARGELY FREE OF INCIDENTS OF TARGETS IN AREAS WHERE SL TRADITIONALLY HAS NOT OPERATED, SUCH AS THE OIL PIPELINE AND CHIMBOTE.
