2. ACTIVITIES REPORTED WEDNESDAY, OCT. 22, 1986  
 - SENDERO LUMINOSO (SL) KILLED FIVE JEHOVAH'S WITNESSES AND INJURED AN EQUAL NUMBER OCT. 19, 1986 IN TOTOTORO, ABOUT 30 KMS NORTHEAST OF AYACUCHO. NEWSPAPER REPORTS SAY THE TERRORISTS INTERRUPTED A CHURCH SERVICE AND SPRAYED THE WORSHIPPERS WITH MACHINE-GUN FIRE.

- SIX PEASANTS WERE KILLED IN HERMILIO VALDIZAN, ABOUT

24 KMS NORTH OF TINGO MARIA. NEWSPAPER REPORTS SAY AN UNKNOWN NUMBER OF SENDERISTAS MARCHED INTO TOWN ABOUT 2 A.M., OCT. 22, ROUNDED UP THE INHABITANTS AND MADE THEM WATCH THE EXECUTIONS. AFTER THE MURDERS, THE TERRORISTS PAINTED HAMMERS AND SICKLES ON THE

VICTIMS' BACKS.

- THE NATIONAL POLICE FORCE REPORTED THE CAPTURE OF 32 TERRORISTS IN SIMULTANEOUS RAIDS IN THE DEPARTMENTS OF LIMA AND PUNO THE MORNING OF OCT. 19. NEWSPAPER REPORTS SAY ONE OF THE ARRESTEES WAS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DEATH OF TWO POLICEMEN OCT. 18 IN LIMA. ANOTHER FIVE WERE SAID TO BE PREPARING FOR SELECTIVE ASSASSINATIONS IN AREQUIPA.

- TWO SUSPECTED TERRORISTS WOUNDED IN A SHOOTOUT WITH POLICE OCT. 4 IN PUNO WERE ARRESTED OCT. 21 IN AREQUIPA BY MEMBERS OF THE PERUVIAN INVESTIGATIVE POLICE. THE TWO ARE SUSPECTED OF KILLING TWO POLICE OFFICERS, ACCORDING TO NEWSPAPER REPORTS.

- AN ARMY PATROL KILLED THREE TERRORISTS ON OCT. 15, IN THE DEPARTMENT OF AYACUCHO. AN ANNOUNCEMENT IN THE GOVERNMENT PAPER "EL PERUANO" ALSO REPORTED THE DEATHS OF TWO UNIDENTIFIED TERRORISTS ON OCT. 16.

- POLICE REPORTED THE DYNAMITE ATTACK AGAINST THE TOWN HALL, THE APRA OFFICE AND A BRANCH OF BANCO DE LA NACION IN THE TOWN OF SUPE, ABOUT 180 KMS OUTSIDE OF LIMA. THE NEWSPAPER ACCOUNT SAID THERE WERE NO INJURIES.

3. OCT. 24, 1986

-TERRORISTS CREATED WHAT APPEARS TO BE LIMA'S FIRST "DOG-BOMB" BY TYING EXPLOSIVES TO A DOG AND THEN COVERING THEM WITH A PERUVIAN FLAG. THE BOMB

EXPLODED IN THE COMAS REGION OF LIMA, KILLING THE DOG BUT CAUSING NO OTHER INJURIES. TWO OTHER BOMBS IN THE CITY WERE FOUND AND DE-ACTIVATED. IN PRESS REPORTS, POLICE ATTRIBUTED THE DOG-BOMB TO THE TUPAC AMARU REVOLUTIONARY MOVEMENT (MRTA).

4. OCT. 25, 1986

- THE ARMED FORCES REPORTED THE DEATH OF 39 SUBVERSIVES IN THE EMERGENCY ZONE BETWEEN OCT. 18 AND 23. AMONG THE DEAD, ACCORDING TO NEWSPAPER REPORTS IS THE ALLEGED NUMBER-3 MAN OF SL, CLAUDIO BELLIDO HUAYTALLA ("CAMARADA CASZELLI"). HE REPORTEDLY DIED WHEN A MEETING OF SL LEADERS IN AYACUCHO WAS ATTACKED. LOCAL OBSERVERS HAD NOT HEARD OF BELLIDO BEFORE AND WERE UNSURE WHAT POSITION HE HAD HELD IN SL.

 INJURY BY THE GUARDIA CIVIL.

6. OCT. 27, 1986  
 - POLICE FOUND FOUR BOMBS IN A STADIUM IN AREQUIPA AND  
 A CAR BOMB IN THE MAIN SQUARE OF PUNO ON OCT. 25,  
 IMMEDIATELY BEFORE VISITS TO THESE LOCATIONS BY

PRESIDENT GARCIA. PRESS REPORTS SAID ALL THE BOMBS  
 WERE DE-ACTIVATED BY POLICE.  
 - TERRORISTS KILLED TWO AND WOUNDED TWO OTHERS OUTSIDE  
 OF LIMA, OCT. 26. NEWSPAPER REPORTS SAY A GROUP OF  
 ARMED SUBVERSIVES ENTERED A MARKET TO SOLICIT MONEY  
 FOR THEIR CAUSE. A GUARD SOUNDED AN ALARM AND THE

TERRORISTS STARTED SHOOTING.

- THE GOVERNMENT OF SWEDEN, OCT. 26, ANNOUNCED IT WOULD EXPEL SEVEN PERUVIANS THOUGHT TO BE MEMBERS OF SENDERO LUMINOSO. THE PERUVIANS HAD REPORTEDLY BEEN COLLECTING MONEY FOR SL AND WERE FOUND PAINTING REVOLUTIONARY SLOGANS ON THE PERUVIAN EMPASSY IN STOCKHOLM. NEWSPAPER REPORTS SAID THE GROUP HAD SOUGHT POLITICAL ASYLUM IN SWEDEN.

- APPROXIMATELY 100 SENDERNISTAS MARCHED INTO THE SMALL TOWN OF RICARDO PALMA IN THE TINGO MARIA AREA ON OCT. 26, ROUNDED UP ABOUT 1,200 RESIDENTS AND KILLED THREE TOWNSPEOPLE IN FRONT OF THEM.

NEWSPAPER REPORTS SAID THE TERRORISTS HELD A "PEOPLE'S COURT" BEFORE THE EXECUTIONS.

7. OCT. 28, 1986

- THE PRESIDENT OF THE CIVIL DEFENSE COMMITTEE OF PATA PATA, ABOUT 100 KMS NORTHEAST OF AYACUCHO WAS KILLED OCT. 26. NEWSPAPER REPORTS SAY ABOUT 25 SUBVERSIVES, KILLED THE LEADER, BURNED SEVERAL DWELLINGS AND PAINTED SLOGANS AGAINST THE UPCOMING MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS.

- A POLICEMAN WAS KILLED AND SEVERAL BUILDINGS DAMAGED OCT. 26 DURING BOMBINGS IN CUZCO AND TRUJILLO. ACCORDING TO NEWSPAPER REPORTS, THE POLICEMAN DIED IN THE CUZCO NEIGHBORHOOD OF "VIVA EL PERU" WHEN HE

WAS PATROLLING THE PUEBLO-JOVEN. A SECOND POLICEMAN AND CIVILIAN SUFFERED INJURIES IN THE ATTACK.

- POLICE ANNOUNCED THE ARREST OF JUSTINIANO ROMERO HUALLPA ("CAMARADA JULIO"), SUSPECTED IN THE MURDER OF A POLICE OFFICER JULY 13, 1986. UNDER "SEVERE INTERROGATION," ACCORDING TO NEWSPAPER REPORTS, ROMERO ADMITTED TO BEING A MEMBER OF SL AND LED POLICE TO A SAFEHOUSE WHERE EXPLOSIVE MATERIALS AND SUBVERSIVE LITERATURE WERE FOUND.

- AN ANNOUNCEMENT BY THE JOINT COMMAND REPORTED THE DEATH OF 3 SUSPECTED TERRORISTS ON OCT. 24 IN TWO SEPARATE INCIDENTS IN AYACUCHO. A POLICE OFFICER WAS ALSO INJURED IN THE EVENTS.

- POLICE IN HUANUCO HAVE ARRESTED 10 SUSPECTS FOLLOWING THE MURDER OCT. 24 OF A PERUVIAN MANAGER OF THE PEPSI-COLA PLANT IN THAT TOWN.
