Upon review, it has been determined that one document contains information furnished by another government agency, therefore, this document has been referred for review and return to DIA. When that review has been completed you will be notified.



Subsection (b)(2) applies to information which pertains solely to the internal rules and practices of the Agency. All reasonably segregable portions of these documents are attached hereto.

All substantive portions of the remaining 10 documents are not releasable. There are no reasonably segregable portions of this exempt material. The information withheld is exempt from release pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 552 (b)(1) and (b)(2), Freedom of Information Act.

SUMMARY: TEN PERUVIAN ARMY (EP) PERSONNEL AND FOUR
CIVILIANS WERE KILLED IN A SHINING PATH (SL) AMBUSH
ON 19 APR 67. AMBUSH SHOWS INCREASING EFFECTIVENESS
OF SL GUERRILLA OPERATIONS.

TEXT: 1. ACCORDING TO OPEN SOURCE REPORTING, FOURTEEN
PEOPLE WERE KILLED IN A SHINING PATH (SL) AMBUSH PREPARED
BY SHINING PATH (SL) NEAR HUACHOCOLPA IN HUACAJELICA
DEPARTMENT//GEOCOORDS: 12553 7456W.

2. THE AMBUSH WAS SPRUNG ON THE HIGHWAY NEAR THE "POP-
FIADO" BRIDGE AS THE SOLDIERS WERE HEADED TO HUACHOCOLPA
FOR A FLAG-RAISING CEREMONY ON A SUNDAY MORNING. AS THE
VEHICLE CAME INTO THE KILL ZONE, AN EXPLOSIVE CHARGE WAS
SET OFF, DISABLING IT. AS THE SOLDIERS DISMOUNTED,
OR WERE THROWN OFF BY THE EXPLOSION AS SOME REPORTS
HAVE IT, SL GUERRILLAS BROUGHT AUTOMATIC WEAPONS FIRE
TO BEAR ON THEM, LATER ESCAPING WITH THE SOLDIERS WEAPONS.

3. THE VICTIMS WERE ONE EP SUB-LIEUTENANT, FIVE SERGEANTS,
FOUR CORPORALS, AND FOUR CIVILIANS. THREE OTHER EP SER-
GEANTS WERE WOUNDED IN THE AMBUSH. TWO OF THE CIVILIANS

WERE LATER IDENTIFIED AS EMPLOYEES OF THE "BUENAVENTURA"
MINE LOCATED IN THE AREA AND THE TWO OTHERS HAD HITCHED
A RIDE TO HUACHOCOLPA.

4. ACCORDING TO PRESS REPORTS, THE "BUENAVENTURA" MINE
HAD BEEN THE TARGET OF SL ATTACKS IN 1955 AND JUNE 1965
ON BOTH OCCASIONS DYNAMITE HAD BEEN STOLEN IN THE ATTACKS.
ONE PRESS REPORT HAD REPORTED THAT THE VEHICLE USED BY
THE ARMY PERSONNEL WAS THE PROPERTY OF THE MINE. ALSO,
A MILITARY PATROL HAS BEEN DISPATCHED TO TRACK DOWN THE
AMBUSHERS.

5. OTHER REPORTS HAVE APPEARED IN THE OPEN PRESS OF SL
GUERRILLAS USING WALKIE TALKIES FOR COMMUNICATIONS WHILE
BLOCKING ROADS AND CHARGING "CUPOS" OR REVOLUTIONARY
TAXES TO SUPPORT THE "ARMED STRUGGLE" NEAR HUARAZ//GEO-
COORDS: 09325 7732W//.

COMMENTS: 1. THIS TYPE OF MILITARY STYLE AMBUSH DEMON-
STRATES THE INCREASING EFFECTIVENESS OF SL GUERRILLA
OPERATIONS. THE OBVIOUS RESULTS ARE FORCING THE PERUVIAN
MILITARY INTO A MORE DEFENSIVE POSTURE AND LOWERING OF
MORALE. THESE TYPE OF ATTACKS ARE EXPECTED TO INCREASE
IN FREQUENCY AND EFFECTIVENESS. SL BENEFITS FROM THIS
TYPE OF OPERATION ARE INCREASED COMBAT EXPERIENCE,
HEIGHTENED MORALE, AND INCREASED MILITARY CAPABILITIES
ASSOCIATED WITH CAPTURED WEAPONS/EQUIPMENT.

2. THE REPORTS OF SL USING WALKIE TALKIES FOR COMMUNI-
CATIONS ARE NOT NEW, BUT THE INCREASING FREQUENCY WITH
WHICH INCREASED FIREPOWER AND COMMUNICATIONS HAVE BEEN
USED BY SL DEMONSTRATES THEIR HIGHER LEVEL OF "MILITARY"
CAPABILITIES FOR THEIR ARMED WING, THE EGP OR POPULAR
GUERRILLA ARMY.

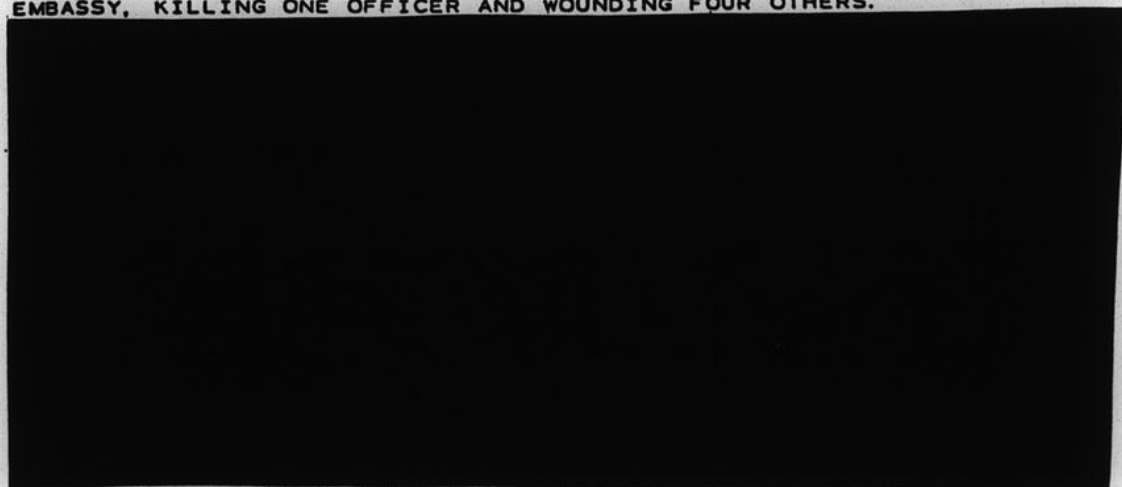

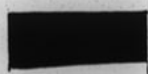

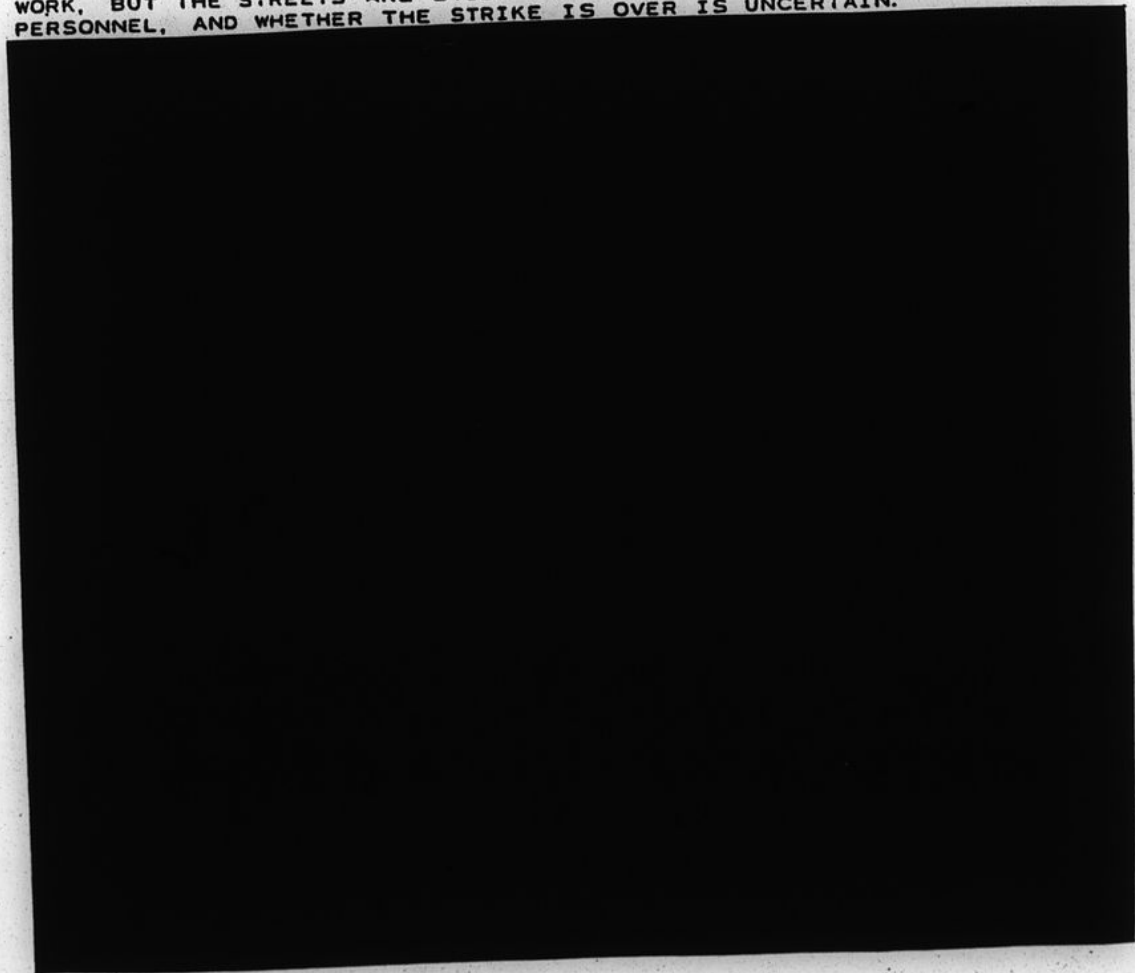

- B. (U) PERU: ON 19 MARCH, SENDERO LUMINOSO (SL) TERRORISTS ATTACKED A BUS FULL OF CIVILIAN AND MILITARY PASSENGERS IN HUANCAMELICA, KILLING AT LEAST 13 PEOPLE.
