SUBJ: NEW TERRORIST ACTIONS IN LINA

1. (U) FOR THE THIRD TIME IN FOUR DAYS, TERRORISTS ATTACKED POINTS WITHIN THE CITY OF LIMA. A POLICE STATION WAS HIT WITH AT LEAST ONE OFFICER KILLED. OTHER BUILDINGS INCLUDING THE ADMINISTRATION BUILDING OF SAN MARCOS UNIVERSITY RECEIVED LIGHT DAMAGE, BUT NO OTHER CASUALTIES WERE REPORTED. EMBASSY PERSONNEL LIVING IN THE VICINITY OF THE POLICE STATION HEARD SHOOTING AND EXPLOSIONS.

2. (U) FOLLOWING ON THE HEELS OF THE BLACKOUT OF LIMA THE

MIGHT OF JULY 21 (SEE REFTEL) AND THE DESTRUCTION OF MAVIGATION EQUIPMENT AT JORGE CHAVEZ AIRPORT ON JULY 24 (SEE PARAGRAPH 4). TERRORISTS INCREASED THE FEELING OF CONCERN IN LIMA WITH COORDINATED ATTACKS JULY 28 AT 1945 HRS ON POLICE INSTALLATIONS. THE MAJOR ASSAULT WAS ON AN INVESTIGATIVE POLICE (PIP) STATION LOCATED IN MIRAFLORES. A SUBURB WHICH IS HOME TO MAY FOREIGNERS. THE TERRORISTS FOLLOWED THE PATTERN OF THEIR EARLIER ATTACK ON THE HEADQUARTERS OF THE GOVERNING PARTY JULY 11 (SEE LIMA 7247). FIRST SPRAYING THE STATION WITH MACHINEGUM FIRE AND THEN THROWING EXPLOSIVES. THREE POLICEMEN WERE WOUNDED. ONE MORTALLY, ONE REQUIRING AMPUTATION OF

- 3. (U) SIMULTAMEOUS ATTACKS DESTROYED TWO POWER TOWERS. CUTTING POWER TO SOME SECTIONS OF THE CITY. SEVERAL OTHER EXPLOSIVES WERE MURLED. DAMAGING THE HOME OF A POLICE OFFICIAL. DESTROYING A CAR. BLOWING OUT WINDOWS IN THE DOWNTOWN BUILDING HOUSING THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF SAM MARCOS (LOCATED CLOSE TO AMOTHER POLICE STATION AND THE PERUYIAN MILITARY COMMAND HEADQUARTERS). AND. IN AMOTHER CASE, EXPLODING HARMLESSLY IN THE BACK OF A POLICE STATION IN A SUBURB.
- COMSISTED OF EXPLOSIVE DEVICES THROWN AT TRANSHITTERS AND AMTERMAE LOCATED MEAR A PERUVIAN CIVIL AIR STATION 10 CAPACITY FOR A SHORT TIME. DATT IS CHECKING OUT TRUE EXTEND OF DAMAGE. WHICH TIED UP AIR TRAFFIC COMING INTO LIMA. (INITIAL DATT ASSESSMENT IS-MORE THAN \$1,000,000.)

ON LIMA IS STEPPING UP, DESPITE THE ATTEMPTS OF THE GOP TO ELIMINATE THEM ALTOGETHER. THE ABILITY TO MOUNT CONTINUAL ASSAULTS, DESPITE POLICE DRAGMETS ACROSS THE CITY, SUGGEST AN ORGANIZATION THAN PREVIOUSLY SUPPOSED. FURTHERMORE, THE DIVERSITY OF SENDERO TARGETS IN LIMA OVER PAST FEW WEEKS UNDERSCORES DIFFICULTY:
